

The Rio 2016 Olympic Committee announced an upcoming bid for the implementation and maintenance of an IT security system for the new headquarters of the Rio 2016 Olympic Committee. The Committee is looking for a proposal that includes the Development of an Operational Concept of Security, a description of the proposed system of command and control center and software, description of system of access and digital identification. Applicants are required to have proven experience with this type of service demonstrating at least 5 previous successful implementations. RFP will be due by February 18, 2013.
