



# U.S. Airport Infrastructure Webinar Brazil

Brazil has recently announced a round of airport concessions that will provide exciting opportunities for U.S. Companies in 2016. Join the U.S. Commercial Service to learn how your company can participate in modernizing and expanding Brazil's airports as part of Brazil's \$133 billion Logistics Investment Program (PIL).

The webinar will include the Brazilian Aviation Secretariat to provide critical information to companies interested to understand plans to build new, and expand existing airports in Brazil. A second speaker will focus on how U.S. companies can participate in the expansion.

In 2016, four critical international airports will be privatized: Fortaleza, Florianopolis, Porto Alegre and Salvador. Lead concessionaires responsible for implementing and maintaining the newly privatized airports, need strong partners and suppliers to support their bids. Learn how your business can participate. Planned investments and upgrades in these four airports will total \$2.8 billion; \$1 billion in Salvador, \$830 million in Porto Alegre, \$600 million in Fortaleza and \$360 million in Florianopolis.

The Webinar will also complement and highlight the new Brazil Transportation Resource Guide, a 155-page book produced by the U.S. Trade Development Agency (USTDA), which provides best prospect opportunities for U.S. exporters in four primary categories - airports, highways, ports, and rail.
