



Frank M. Nuñez first began his career with the Fresno CITD in 2007 as the Program Development Assistant, a position he still holds today. He also serves as the coordinator for the statewide implementation of the California Agricultural Export Training Program “CalAgX”. As the CalAgX coordinator, Mr. Nuñez has already provided more than 300 “new-to-exporting” food and agricultural companies with advance export training with many companies already making export sales in excess of \$100,000. In addition to this responsibility and all other training programs, Mr. Nuñez is charged with facilitating advisory board meetings, focus groups, international seminars at the World Ag Expo, and new grant research and development.

Prior to Mr. Nuñez’ tenure at the CITD, he was the director at a local vocational school for nine years during which time he was instrumental in developing the training curriculum for nine vocational programs, expanding business capacity, training students, job placement of graduates, and acquiring over \$500,000 in grant funding to train young adults.

Mr. Nuñez is a graduate of California State University, Fresno where he earned a bachelor’s degree in Psychology.
