SUMMIT on 8 June 2016 | MCA, Mumbai

E-commerce is India's fastest growing and most exciting channel for commercial transactions. The rapid rise in Internet and digital device penetration in the world's second most populous country has contributed to unprecedented growth in the sector.

The debate over whether India should open up e-commerce to FDI has been long and often bitter. Recently, India has allowed 100 percent FDI in business-to-consumers or B2C e-commerce. Allowing FDI in ecommerce will encourage global players to bring their successful e-commerce models and global best practices to India.

Issues related to payment and tax adversely affect e-commerce. The credit card or plastic money has not become popular so far in India as the penetration of credit card in India is very low and the Indian customers are quite skeptical of paying by credit card with the increasing threat of fraud played by hackers. Establishing incidence of tax in case of e-commerce transactions becomes difficult, providing ample scope for tax evasion.
