He is the Team Coordinator for U.S. Commercial Service Brazil Finance sector and construction/architectural/engineering services, providing market analysis and business consulting in such industry sectors and expert level support to U.S. programs in Brazil.

He also conducts export control investigations for Commerce's Bureau of Export Administration (BXA) in assigned industry sectors, facilitates U.S. anti-dumping investigation team visits to Brazil and provides support to other USG agencies such as EXIMBANK, OPIC and TDA.

From 1988-2000, Patrick Levy was Massachusetts Port Authority's (Massport) Account Manager for Brazil, being the responsible in Brazil for Massport's activities; Usinor Brasil (now a branch of the worldwide steel leading producer Arcelor Mittal) Commercial Manager, and Pechiney World Trade Brazil (branch of the aluminum and packaging world leading group Pechiney) CEO's adviser.

Born in São Paulo, Brazil, Patrick Levy is a graduate of the School of Law of the University of São Paulo and attended The Hague Academy of International Law (The Hague, Netherlands) and the International Institute of Human Rights (University of Strasbourg, France).
