







Nashville-Davidson-Murfreesboro-Franklin, TN

- In 2014, Nashville was the 33rd largest metropolitan area exporter in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$9.6 billion. This is up \$918 million (10.5 percent) from the \$8.7 billion in merchandise exported in 2013.
- In 2012 (latest data available), 1,693 companies exported goods from the Nashville metropolitan area. Of these, 1,390 were small- or medium-sized exporters (SMEs) with fewer than 500 employees.
- The Nashville metropolitan area accounted for 30.0 percent of Tennessee's merchandise exports in 2014.
- Counties from the Nashville metropolitan area that reported exports in 2014 included: Rutherford County (\$3.8 billion), Wilson County (\$1.8 billion), Davidson County (\$1.4 billion), Williamson County (\$883 million), Maury County (\$767 million), Sumner County (\$463 million), Robertson County (\$239 million), Dickson County (\$75 million), Trousdale County (\$14 million). The following counties recorded exports, but the values are suppressed due to federal disclosure regulations: Cheatham County.
- In 2014, Nashville's top export markets included Canada (\$4.2 billion), Mexico (\$1.6 billion), China (\$460 million), United Arab Emirates (\$310 million), and United Kingdom (\$302 million). In addition to these markets, Nashville also ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Kuwait.
- Top export sectors from Nashville in 2014 were transportation equipment (\$4.1 billion); computer & electronic products (\$2.2 billion); machinery, except electrical (\$521 million); chemicals (\$497 million); and electrical equipment & components (\$467 million). Nashville is also a major metropolitan area exporter of fabricated metal products; textiles and fabrics; plastics and rubber products; miscellaneous manufactures; and printed matter and related products.
- In 2014, Nashville benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting 70.5 percent of merchandise exports to free trade agreement (FTA) partners.
- In 2014, Nashville exported \$5.8 billion in goods to the NAFTA region and \$159 million in goods to the CAFTA-DR region.
